Looking back through history...

And it MAY HAVE begun as far back as in the garden, the Garden of Eden THAT IS.

BECAUSE THIS WILL BE WORTH YOUR TIME.

Most of us are familiar with that scene in Genesis where the serpent...**that would be the devil**,  
tempted Eve with the infamous apple,

I hate to admit this.... but for a long time I didn't realize Adam was right there, apparently standing behind Eve, observing the entire thing.

Hanging our like a typical GUY...SAYING AND DOING NOTHING!

AND if you recall...God created Eve out of Adam as a SUITABLE helper.

They were the first couple. The first husband and wife.

BUT Adam rightfully so... gets CHARGED with the sin.

**And that's' as it should be!!!**

MOVING FORWARD...

In most cultures throughout history WOMAN was SUBORDINANT to the male species, including her husband.

Very often she was regarded **as property,**

She was **clearly treated as being inferior**

The consequences of this thinking resulted in WOMEN being denied an education.... unless it was in regard to tending to the home,

She was unable to **enter into contracts, bring suit,**

AND in **much more recent history**...and we're all aware of this...

**to have a voice in the public forum** including the right to vote,

A RIGHT that was not granted to her UNTIL she went after it.

**What does that tell you???**

There are **FEW.... VERY FEW....** examples in history where women **were on equal footing with men.**

The Sumerian women in the **3<sup>rd</sup> millennium BC...THAT'S 5000 years ago!** Got the closest to this ... BUT as you can probably guess....

That didn't last long. By the 2<sup>nd</sup> millennium it's gone.

**and its pretty much been that way ever since.**

In antiquity, Egyptian women fared the best, and well into the time after the birth of Christ as they were afforded the **right to education, the right to be free and almost equal to men...** but even THEY.... never broken the "glass ceiling" ...

**History records then ... this has been the universal plight of women.**

**However, THIS** apparent inequality, initially at least, may not have been a social invention at all.

As far back as nomadic tribes in Africa,  
AND ancient Greek and Roman societies,  
the social role of women WERE as mothers and wives, DAH!

**Men and women are created differently!**

It is somewhat easier to understand HOW and WHY their maternal responsibilities and expectations were **her's.**

**Men were the providers....**

**women were responsible** for the upbringing and the nurturing of their children.

AND FORTUNATELY...Once she is MOM, she forever remains MOM... and most of us are just fine with that.

**Practically speaking**, the role of women... quite naturally... centered around the home, the family, **and this INCLUDED**... tending to her husband... [we're pretty frail you know?]

IN Ancient Greek and Roman societies...WIVES were to be **held in respect** for fulfilling their maternal duties. But, how far that went is unclear.

First century Judaism wasn't much different than Greek and Roman society,

..the womans role was predetermined to the customary maternal and societal positions.

**BUT** ...As societies supposedly evolved ...

**women's status began to change, based on one thing...** [PAUSE]

**Her status....or class.** Women in the **upper class or elite** were afforded the opportunity for higher education, **and** the perks that came along with it, even to the degree of **being influential** to male leaders around them.

In looking back in Antiquity...some women broke through the established patriarchy...**BUT NOT MANY**... and all of them were of the elite class.

This may **not have applied** to the mythological Amazon Warrior Women of Greek mythology, but the jury is out as to whether or not they were mythological or real.

As for ancient Greece and Rome... there seems to only have been one woman who cut through the patriarchy of those times. The renowned poet Sapho of Lesbos, whose work was so popular in ancient **Greece** she was honored in statuary, **coinage**, and **pottery**, even centuries after her **death**,

**SHE**.... was the rare exception.

Early in the common era, **that is AFTER the birth of Christ**, there were 3 Warrior Women of old who crashed through the male patriarchal barrier, **BUT** ....in a very unorthodox way for those times.

They were women warriors, in Vietnam, of all places, who were as **courageous** and **valiant** as any of their male counterparts...

FIRST.... THE TRUNG SISTERS: **born** into aristocracy, but they had an ax to grind.

The elder sister Trung Trac, whose husband was a dissident, was assassinated by the Chinese

She took upon herself to assume leadership of their Revolutionary movement and along with her sister in 39 AD led a momentous rebellion against the Chinese who had ruled them for centuries.

**We could use them today.**

They were successful and went on to control sixty-five northern strongholds in the country and eventually created an independent state

but unfortunately they eventually ran out of supplies and support...

but rather than **surrender**???? **Oh no!**

**In their last battle They** took their own lives. **They** limited the spoils of their victors. **Of course we know what would have happened to them if they had been taken prisoners**

These same Sisters inspired yet another Vietnamese woman, in the **third century**,

**Ba Trieu**, became known as the **Vietnamese Joan of Arc**.

It's difficult to determine what is fact or fiction concerning her because she apparently was a physical specimen, I mean....**BIG and beautiful**.

At age 19, her brother, a powerful leader in their district tried to get her married off, **and you can guess how that went...**

**she would have none of it.**

History records as her brother prepared for battle, she gathered her **OWN** army of 1000 fighters and assisted her brother in battle to gain victory. The army was so impressed with her fighting skills they declared her their leader.

**But again...eventually** the Chinese were too much for them and at the age of 23 Ba Trieu ALSO.... took her own life rather than be captured when she was defeated in battle.

These women didn't go down easily and they never allowed themselves to be VICTIMIZED as women so after are in battle.

and today... **Ba Trieu is a renowned national hero of Vietnam** revered by Vietnamese women as a fighter against oppression.

**Interestingly**....I was never aware of the folklore of these Vietnamese warrior women when I was on assignment there but all I can say is I'm glad I never crossed any "mama sons" I knew while I was there. Not that I ever would have, but such information would have been good to have.

**This Status Quo... ,the Social Order, of "patriarchy"...** continued through the **Middle Ages**.

Again, it was primarily women born into wealthy noble families who enjoyed the privileges of education and everything that went along with it giving them influence within their households and beyond.

As for Women of the masses,...this would be who we refer to as Middle Class and the poor...

the peasants and slave class of those times...

**LIFE** ...was harsh and labor-intensive,

saddled with not only their domestic tasks of bearing and raising children,

**but also**

baking, brewing, clothes-making, everything else vital to a households' survival.

**LEGALLY...Women of the peasant class** weren't much better off than the slave class.

The courts usually enforced traditional gender roles and expectations, leaving them with limited recourse.

While they weren't considered property, like the slaves,

for all practical purposes their lot wasn't much different.

They were **commoners** who remained 2<sup>nd</sup> class citizens.

**PAUSE**

There was **ONE OPPORTUNITY.... HOWEVER**

for them to break out of this milieu,

and that was the trade and craft guilds,

BUT still....they had to have the opportunity to learn these trades.

**Some** “commoners” were able to avail themselves to this opportunity but again it was **primarily Upper class women who benefited**

affording them the opportunity to gain economic and political power.

In Paris and London for example... female artisans and merchants, such as the silk-weavers, played key roles in those economies.

**Upward mobility was nearly impossible for women in the lower classes**

**There WAS another development, not entirely beneficial though,**

**But UNMARRIED WOMEN,** the 'femme soul' were granted the ability to

**conduct business... own property... and enter contracts** independently, giving them freedom and autonomy their married counterparts did not enjoy.

This may have been one of the first direct attacks on the FAMILY

which has ALWAYS been under tremendous economic and social pressures...

**BUT giving single women additional legal prerogatives** not available to their married counterparts was a direct affront both to women and to the family...

**There seems to be a pattern emerging here...DOESN'T THERE?**

SO we may be able to look back at the Middle Ages as perhaps the

first time where the state placed their hands on the scales of gender equality... adversely affecting the family?

This was obviously a social invention of the state so they wouldn't be financially responsible,

but the question remains.... And **THIS** encompasses what should be considered.... honorable, moral, and ethical.

### **WHY weren't ALL WOMEN worthy of this consideration?**

This policy along with all the rest I've been discussing contributed to the continuation of societies view and treatment of women!!!

**One positive policy** some cultures had was special consideration

for **WIDOWS**.

**SOME STATES'** gave them their own legal status.

They could own property, manage estates, and sometimes engage in legal disputes. Which is all well and good...

***BUT...you can't help wonder if this might have given some husbands cause for concern? Some women might have considered themselves better off without their husbands.***

***What effect this might have had on their culture is unclear***

***BUT for women widowed in old age... it most likely would not have***

*benefited her very much.*

So, for whatever the reasons....

there always has been prejudices against women.

Patriarchy was the rule of day so those who believe this was a power play by some church or religious leaders???

**THAT'S JUST SILLY!**

**It'S Man's depravity, his SIN NATURE...**

**the need for power and control for some**

that had more to do with this than anything.

**There's no question** The consequences of this **interminable, prejudicial** view of women lingers on,

I believe there are some women today who, **rightly or wrongly,**

I don't know..... who hold at least some or all men in contempt.

Some women have an antagonism for what they perceive is this

“dog eat dog” world, it's **MAN AGAINST WOMAN.**

Maybe **this,** is a residual effect of humanities past....**OR....**

**Could it be from something happening today? Something to think about.**

If we're honest... which doesn't happen very often with this subject...

MEN must recognize women have been DEHUMANIZED throughout history and it continues today and I believe it is a grave error to dismiss **THIS simply as historical reality.**
